What: ‘The Barn: A Portland Raised Building’ is a Nonprofit Support Center currently in pre-development by [MotiveSpace](#). At an estimated 120,000+ square feet, and with a draft budget of \$27 million, **the Barn will be the first building of its kind in the nation.** A true community asset, **the Barn will offer equity building opportunities to tenants, and will reinvest its net revenue into support programs benefitting tenants. Program ideas under discussion at this time include: shared services programs, job training programs, and a ‘social profit store’ selling products that support tenant missions.**
